ULA Breaks Ground on \$317 Million Facilities to Increase Rocket Production





ULA held a ground-breaking ceremony on October 27, 2022 for the company's new \$317 million warehouse and an additional factory facility. The expansion will allow ULA to nearly double its launch rate, according to company officials.

The new buildings will serve to support ULA's contract with Amazon for Project Kuiper, an ambitious global broadband connectivity effort aimed at providing high-speed internet services to underserved areas around the world.

Beyond Gravity, a major supplier to ULA, will provide 38 payload fairings for the Vulcan rocket which will be utilized for the project. The investment will result in the creation of approximately 200 jobs.

ULA President and CEO Tory Bruno expressed the rocket manufacturer's gratitude for the support it has received from community leadership.
